SETTLING-IN

The first few weeks when a child is settling into an early years setting is a time of crucial importance to their later happiness in the setting. All children are individuals and while some children will adjust fairly easily to the new environment and new routines, others will take longer to feel comfortable and secure. Separation anxiety is a healthy and protective emotion. It is the child's way of saying "You are my safe base and I need to develop trust and confidence in alternate carers." Practitioners will have a vast amount of experience in helping children settle into the pre-school setting and are aware of the difficulties that can emerge during this transition period. If your child is taking longer to settle in than you had expected and you still have concerns, please discuss these with your child's key worker. Together you can agree on and put into place strategies to support your child during this time. For more information on our 'settling in policy' and all of our policies please visit our website.
